His role is to listen to you, your aspirations and ideas for the future of your neighborhood and translate this important feedback into drawings and plans that will support and guide your vision into the future. A safe, resilient neighborhood connects people to the things they need on a daily basis, access to fresh food, parks, and education.

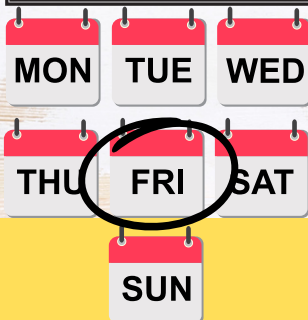


World Autism
